Cross View Farm 2018 Show Series

Rules, Regulations, and Important Information

While we don't anticipate significant changes, we reserve the right to alter the below information as we deem it appropriate.

General Information

- Goodwill and sportsmanship are essential for a fun and safe show. Management reserves the right to excuse/bar any animal, exhibitor, owner, or spectator for inappropriate behavior. Decisions made by management are final.
- **Driving directions:** I-81 to Exit 137, make right onto Rt. 619 (Wildwood Rd). Right at traffic light onto Rt. 11 South (460W & West Main) and go ¾ mile. Turn left onto Rt. 639 (Diuguids Lane) at traffic light. ALL TRAILERS: Entrance 1 mile on right. ALL OTHER TRAFFIC: Entrance 1 ¼ miles on right. There will be signs.
- **Show Start Times:**
 - Morning Hunter Ring – 8:30
 - Afternoon Hunter Ring – Starts after 30 min break from morning show (will not start before 1PM)
 - Morning Jumper Ring – 10:00
 - Open Show – 9:00 There will be a 30 minute break after class 28
 - Trail Ring – 9:30-12:00
 - Games Ring – 1:00
- **Stabling**
 - Overnight stabling will be available on a limited first come basis. You MUST call ahead to reserve a stall for overnight stabling. Only horses are permitted to stable over night. Exhibitors may not camp or stay at the park overnight. There will be staff overnight and phone numbers may be left to call in case of emergency. Gates will close at 9 PM and gates will reopen at 6 AM. Cost for overnight stabling for the weekend is \$60. Stalls must be stripped after use.
 - Day stalls will not be reserved until the day of the show and will be based on availability after overnight stalls have been filled. Cost for Day stalls is \$20. Stalls must be stripped after use.
- A two minute gate call and five minute tack change will be enforced.
- Show management reserves the right to add, cancel, divide or combine classes.
- Each horse/rider combination must have a separate and unique back number.
- Negative Coggins Test results within the last twelve months must be provided for every horse on the grounds. Documentation required at time of registration.
- Alcohol and firearms are prohibited.
- Respect all facilities and personal property.
- Dogs/pets must be under control and on a leash at all times.
- Horses may not be left unattended or in the control of a minor without adult supervision.
- Call the contact number in case of bad weather (540) 529-4097. Generally, this show will go on **rain or shine**.

Liability

- Cross View Farm, Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, Blue Ridge Horse Force, Franklin County Equestrian Club, show management, show sponsors, employees, and any other staff affiliated with the horse show assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury or damage to persons, horses, or personal property for any cause and admittance and entries are accepted only on this basis.
- All participants must sign a Release of Liability waiver form to participate.

Payment

- An open check, made out to **Cross View Farm** must be left with the secretary to ensure payment of fees. Alternatively, you may pay in full with credit card, paypal, or cash.
- Class fees are \$9.
- Money class fees are \$25 unless otherwise noted.
- **NO Refunds given on gift certificates**

Clarifications

- The Show will be run according to BRHF Rules, unless otherwise noted.
- Show appropriate attire is encouraged, but not required.
- Helmet required in all over fence classes and youth games classes. Protective/safety gear will not be penalized.
- Beginner Horse may NOT be exhibited by a Beginner Rider
- Coached Division: Coach is allowed in the ring to give verbal assistance (may assist if safety is in jeopardy). Riders may cross enter to Leadline, In-Hand Trail, Model, and other coached classes.
- Youth riders must be 17 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2015.
- Junior horses must be 5 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2015. Junior horses are allowed two-handed riding with snaffle bits without a shank or bosals.
- Could be asked in Equitation on the Flat classes: halt, back, 2 point/jump position, dismount/mount (individually) drop irons/stirrups, sitting trot, hand gallop, counter canter.
- Boots and other protective leg gear are only allowed in games classes, ranch classes, jumper classes, and hunter equitation. In all other classes the exhibitor will not be judged.
- Martingales are not permitted in hunter under saddle classes.
- Noticeably lame horses will not be pinned and will be excused from class.
- Green Toad Jumper class is NOT BRHF sanctioned and is open to any rider/horse combination.
- Open Cross Rails Hunter Division is NOT BRHF sanctioned. Division will consist of two full courses of cross rails and one WTC under saddle class.
- Pre Beginner Hunter Rider division is NOT BRHF sanctioned. Division will consist of a WT, a GAYP flat class and a course of 4 ground poles.

Prizes

- Judge's decision is final.
- Prizes are 1st through 6th for each class.
- Money classes will pay out based on number of entrants.
- To be eligible for a Cross View Show Series High Point Award, a rider must show the same horse. The High Point Champion will be awarded to the rider/horse combination that acquires the most points in each Division.
- Points will be awarded as follows – 1st place = 6 points, 2nd = 5, 3rd = 4, 4th = 3, 5th = 2, and 6th = 1 point, regardless of the number of class entries
- To be eligible for Cross View Show Series Year End High Point Awards you must show in 2 of 3 shows.
- The show is open to the public. You do not need to be a BRHF or FCEC member to participate.
- Some dates/classes will be BRHF and FCEC sanctioned and you MUST be a member of BRHF or FCEC prior to the show for your points to count toward BRHF or FCEC year-end awards.
- **Champion and Reserve will be awarded for:**
 - **Hunter/Jumper Day** - Baby green hunter, Intermediate hunter, hopeful hunter, schooling hunter, low hunter, open hunter, open cross rail hunter, coached classes, youth classes, adult hunter pleasure, youth hunter pleasure, pre beginner hunter rider, beginner rider hunter pleasure, beginner horse hunter pleasure, frog rails jumper, green toad jumper, Baby green jumper, schooling jumper, hopeful jumper, low jumper
 - **Open Day** – Coached, Youth, beginner rider English, Youth English pleasure, adult English pleasure, beginner rider western pleasure, youth western pleasure, adult western pleasure, open western pleasure, open stock seat equitation, Youth ranch riding, Adult ranch riding
